The Race Office is located at the **Club de Ski Mont-Tremblant Clubhouse**, situated on **de la Chapelle road**, directly after the Tremblant Fairmont Hotel.

Temporary parking is for registration only. You can also park in parking lot P1 at the bottom of the pedestrian village and use the Cabriolet to travel to the base of the mountain and the walk up the hill to the Clubhouse (± 12 minute walk)
