Dear PARA Racer,

Congratulations! Your racing results have qualified you for an invitation to the **2015 PARA U12 State Championships presented by the Tussey Mountain Alpine Racing Team.** 

The weekend long event will be held at **Tussey Mountain**, Friday, February 27, 2015 – Sunday, March 1, 2015. An optional Skills Challenge will be held on Friday, February 27 followed by three SL runs on Saturday, February 28 and three GS runs on Sunday, March 1.

If you cannot participate, notify your PARA Regional Chair immediately! The final racer start list will close at noon on Wednesday, February 25, 2015.

The results from the races at this event will be used to select the following:

The top 10 girls and top 10 boys will be invited to represent PARA at the Francis Piche Invitational. Please be prepared to make a decision as to whether or not you will attend if you qualify. If you decide not to attend or fail to meet the announced registration deadline, your spot will be forfeited and offered to the next racer on the list.

### **Registration and Events**

**REGISTRATION:** Race Registration is available on <u>alpinereg.com</u>. For each racer, the registration fee will cover the following:

Two days of race registration fees and optional Skills Challenge Racer lunch Saturday and Sunday Saturday evening Banquet at the Ramada Conference & Golf Hotel State Championship sweatshirt and Commemorative 2015 Race Bib

The \$125 registration fee does NOT include lift tickets. Lift ticket cost for racers and families is \$37 per day. Advanced 3 day tickets purchased through alpinereg.com offered for \$105 (See Miscellaneous Information page for how to use Alpine Reg). Tickets will also be available for purchase at registration. Payment <a href="must">must</a> be made with cash or check. <a href="must">If paying</a> by credit card, lift tickets must be purchased at the ticket office and will be full price. Complimentary coaches' lift tickets will be issued, not to exceed three complimentary coaches' lift tickets per team, available only at registration.

**BANQUET:** Saturday evening Banquet includes a dinner buffet. The cost is included in each racer's registration fee. **Additional Banquet tickets (friends & family) MUST be purchased on alpinereg.com when registering for the event** (See Miscellaneous Information page for how to use Alpinereg.com). Cost is \$25 per person age 11 and older, \$15 for children 10 and under and \$0 for Children 3 and under. There will be a Cash bar.

<u>SCHEDULE:</u> The attached schedules are tentative and will be confirmed each race day based on conditions and weather. You are responsible for verifying start times and locations on the day of the race.

<u>VOLUNTEERS:</u> Each race team represented is required to bring **AT LEAST ONE RACE WORKER** to fill on-hill positions. <u>AWARDS:</u> Slalom (Top 8 Females and Males); Giant Slalom (Top 8 Females and Males); Overall (Top Female and Top Male); PARA State Team Announcement; and Francis Piche' Invitational Team Designation. Qualification for the State Team and Piche's Team will be determined by **New World Cup Points** based on the <u>TOTAL OF THE FINISHES OF ALL SIX RUNS</u> as determined by circumstances and conditions (weather, snow, etc.). (See PARA/USSA comp guides for explanation of New World Cup Points.)

## **Miscellaneous Information**

#### Rules & Regulations:

Race Bibs will be provided in your Registration Package for use at the Skills Challenge and Saturday and Sunday's Races. (You must have your bib to start.)

<u>All Racers</u> must stage their **equipment** in the designated "**staging area**" at the top of the race hill. No equipment is permitted in the race arena. **Please do not block skier traffic**.

Helmets are required per USSA Rules.

#### Other Information:

- 1. The scoreboard is unofficial.
- 2. Poor sportsmanship/use of inappropriate language will be dealt with as per USSA rules.
- 3. All protests must be filed in writing by **coaches** and must be accompanied by the proper fee of \$50. **Parents are not to approach Race Officials or Gatekeepers regarding any issues.**Questions or protests must be directed to your coaches, who will approach the appropriate Race Officials.
- 4. Trophies and Medals will be awarded to the **top 8 finishers** for Slalom and Giant Slalom.
- 5. Trophies will be awarded to the top overall Female and Male Skier.
- 6. New World Cup points will be used to score each run.
- 7. State Teams and Piche's Invitational Qualification will be determined based on New World Cup points from each of the racers' six runs. Any ties will be broken using the combined time of all 6 runs of the championship event. (See PARA guide.)

#### **Safety Rules:**

- 1. Ski brakes will be required.
- 2. Skiing on the race slope outside the race arena must be at a controlled speed due to the limited area and volume of people.
- 3. Safety bars on chair lifts must be down.
- 4. Leave the finish area, under control, immediately after your run.

#### **Using Alpine Reg.com**

Purchase family lift and banquet tickets using <u>alpinereg.com</u>. To do so, you would always use your racer's USSA # for each purchase. Just complete the purchase cycle for each ticket you want.

Venue: Tussey Mountain, 301 Bear Meadow Rd., Boalsburg, PA 16827
