# PARA U16 Chair Report 2023-2024 Season

## **U16 Field Size**

Due to a large U16 population for the 23-24 season, a new tiered race registration process was utilized to give ranked athletes priority registration. After a several day priority period, registration opened to all PARA U16 athletes. All that wanted to race were able to register even though host venues had set maximum race fields. None of the maximums were met. There were a few glitches with some athletes registering due to "qualified athlete" settings in AdminSkiRacing.

For the 24-25 season there are 58 Male ranked athletes and 45 Female ranked athletes that will be eligible for priority registration for the U16 State-Wide Race Series.

There were a total of 176 U16 athletes in PARA for the 2024 competition season. This is 50 fewer than the prior season. 2024 U16 population comprised of 86 male and 90 female racers.

## **PARA U16 State-wide Race Series**

Warm weather conditions hampered snowmaking and Tussey Mountain was not able to host the first 2 SL races on Jan 27-28. Elk picked up one of the races and hosted 2 GS and 1 SL. Blue hosted U16 Finals with an SG, GS, and SL. Total races for the 2024 series was 6 instead of 7. The 2023 race season was the 3rd season of the PARA U16 statewide series. Field sizes and percent of U16 participation is listed in 2 far right columns of the table below.

A total of 61 of 86 male athletes raced at least one race of the series (71%). 73 of 90 Females raced at least one race of the series (81%). Total for both genders was 134 of 176 (76%).

Both Female and Male events had issues. USSS East did not arrange for coaching for athletes attending without bringing a coach. They had accommodated these athletes in the past. The 2nd day of the male event was canceled while athletes were already at the event venue. Athletes and their parents were unhappy that the decision about canceling was not made earlier. USSS East apologized for pushing to make this project happen.
