The event was to be held the third weekend in March at Whiteface Mountain in Lake Placid NY. Ten PARA athletes would have been invited to participate. Day 1 // Kombi Race - 3 Run Race

Day 2 // GS Race - 3 Run Race

Place points for Awards, Best two finishes.

\*\*Short Sprint Like courses approximately 30 seconds.

Awards - Top 10 U12s M/W age class. Overall Award. Skimeister for top finisher across all 6 runs.

Council Cup for Best Top Finishing Council

Event - to Include some of the following. Sense of Arrival, Recognition of event, Swag, Gift, Banquet, BBQ.

I followed up with Stephen last week. He is planning on holding the event next year. He will provide PARA with the schedule this fall. He feels it is not only a valuable athlete development project, but great coach collaboration and education opportunity.
