

## PARA Gate Judge Education & Certification Program 2014

The PARA gate judge program finished the season with 146 certified judges and 23 chief gate judges. We added 17 new certified judges in the 2013-2014 season, the lowest number of new judges in 3 years. Since many of the athletes of the certified judges have been graduating out of their programs, the number of active judges is probably closer to 110. We encourage the Program Directors, coaches and club presidents to help promote the program within your clubs - particularly to parents of younger athletes.

The program does not include a requirement to take a regular update. To keep the judges updated on rules changes that affect them, there are two emails sent - one after the AO updates, and another around the holidays.

With only a few exceptions, all the clubs are well represented in the number of certified judges, and all the ROC's have at least one certified chief.
