Race Registration

If you are unable to participate, please notify your PARA Region Chairperson as soon as possible so that your quota spot may be assigned to an alternate. Registration is only available to those athletes who have been identified by the PARA Region Chairs as qualifying for this event.

Online registration will close at midnight on Tuesday 3/1.

Entry Fee

The ENTRY FEE is \$150.00, and includes the following for each athlete:

- Race registration for all 3 days of the event (Super G Training, SL, & GS)

3. LIFT TICKETS

Lift tickets are not included with race registration. Adult (racer or parent) and Children lift tickets are purchased separately during Packet Pickup at the following discounted rates.

5. VOLUNTEER SIGNUP

It is requested for each racer to have a parent or friend assist with officiating or gate judging at least one of the race days, either Saturday or Sunday. WPRC honors the PARA Gate Judge Certification Program.

Volunteer duties will be filled on a first come, first served basis. If you have any questions or issues regarding volunteer duties or signup, please contact the Volunteer Coordinator, Mark Tulenko (tulenko1@comcast.net). A signup for race duties will be available at registration.

Instructions for online volunteer signup:

- 1. Go to the volunteer website at: http://volunteer.wprcskiteam.org
 - This signup sheet runs through Google Spreadsheets & Forms. We recommend using a computer. Some of the dropdown selections do not always appear on mobile devices.
- 2. In row 3, select the race
 - Make sure that you have selected one of the PARA U14 States events to see appropriate volunteer duties. It should be one of the following:
 - "3/5/16 PARA U14 States SL"
 - "3/6/16 PARA U14 States GS"
- 3. Review spreadsheet and identify an open duty that you would like to request
 - If a duty has already been requested, a name will appear next to the duty
- 4. Click on the volunteer request form URL in row 1.
 - In Google Spreadsheets, you must first click on the cell with the URL, and then click on the URL in the pop up to launch the request form
- 5. Complete "WPRC Race Volunteer Request" form
 - In the "Volunteer Role" section, make sure you select the race for which you would like to volunteer, either:
 - "3/5/16 PARA U14 States SL"
 - "3/6/16 PARA U14 States GS"
- 6. After submitting your request, return to the volunteer spreadsheet (http://volunteer.wprskiteam.org) to confirm your name appears in the appropriate race duty
 - If the race duty was open prior to your request, your name will automatically appear in the race / duty you requested

6. Additional Rules & Information

General

USSA regulation helmets are mandatory for the Super G Training, Slalom, and Giant Slalom races.

Official Jury postings are posted in the scoreboard window at the bottom of the Timing Hut on Avalanche Slope.

Free parking is available in the hotel area above the WPRC Training Center.

Please DO NOT park in the Ski Patrol parking area at the bottom of

Avalanche – you will be towed.

Event Format and Scoring

The PARA U14 State Championships will consist of 3 runs of Slalom and 3 runs of Giant Slalom, and an optional Super G skills day on Friday. New World Cup points will be assigned for each run of Slalom and Giant Slalom. Overall State Champions and State Team / post-season event selection will be based on total New World Cup Points from the six runs. Tie breaks follow the "Inside/Out Method".

Discipline awards will also be given for Slalom and Giant Slalom based on total New World Cup Points from all three runs of each discipline. Tie breaks follow the "Inside/Out Method".

USSALiveTiming.com

In addition to posting unofficial times to the scoreboard at the finish line, WPRC will use USSALiveTiming.com to provide online access to:

- Start Lists
- Live results
- Final results
- Event scoring

Start lists for all 6 runs of the event will be published to USSALiveTiming.com within 24 hours of the close of registration. Athletes will not receive paper copies of start lists in their Race Packets. If athletes or parents would like paper copies of the start lists, you will need to print them yourselves. Paper copies of the start lists will be provided to all Race Officials and Team Captains.

Super G Training

 To get to Gunnar Slope, athletes will ride the Polar Express from ski lodge, ski down North Face slope, and then take Gunnar lift to start of Super G

venue. Total trip takes ~20 minutes, so athletes need to be ready to go at lift opening.

- Athletes must be present at Super G Training introduction and overview to participate in training exercises and runs.
- No movement on the hill while drills or training runs are in progress.
- Yellow flag during training runs will be positioned on skier's left along flats below first pitch.
- Please remove SL chin bars and pole guards.
- Parking is limited at the base of Gunnar Slope, so spectators must either ski over or take the shuttle.
- Spectators are not allowed in the race arena / course. The best place to view is at the bottom of the hill.
- If parents would like to help during the training day, they are welcome to help with setup and tear down of the venue.
- Plan is to complete all activities before athletes break for lunch. If athletes go
 to lunch, we lose them. Plan for a late lunch. Snacks and water will be
 available at the bottom of Gunnar.

Race Day Communications - Remind

9. MEDICAL PLAN

This is the medical plan for all racing activities while at Seven Springs Mountain Resort.

Relative Homologations: U555/11/09, U556/11/09, U313/11/05 Relative Ski Slopes Used: Avalanche Slope and Gunnar Slope

Medical Plan: The Seven Springs Ski Patrol maintains a full time presence at the ski patrol clinic – located directly adjacent to the finish area on Avalanche Slope. They also dispatch patrol and equipment from medical patrol buildings around the mountain. There is a patrol building 75 meters behind the Avalanche Slope Start, and also one adjacent to the Gunnar Slope Start.

- All of the patrol dispatch locations and the clinic have "trauma sleds" fully equipped with oxygen and AED's.
- Any dispatch from the clinic can use snowmobile to access the injury site.
- Mutual Aid Medical Services (ALS Ambulance Service) is stationed at the clinic as well, with a state certified paramedic & EMT.
- Patients with non-life threatening injuries are transported to either Somerset or Johnstown Hospitals with a travel time of 20 minutes with clear roads.
- Major Trauma facilities are located at Johnstown Hospital and multiple Pittsburgh Hospitals. Travel times via ground are 40 - 60 minutes. Travel times via air are 20 – 30 minutes.
- Life Flight is dispatched from either Johnstown or Pittsburgh. Approximately 20 – 30 minutes flight time. Pre-Coordinated landing facilities for Life Flight are located in the upper parking lot at Seven Springs.
- All Seven Springs Ski Patrollers conform to the NSP guidelines for training & currency.
- Communication with the Patrol Dispatch is via radio on channel #2 on all of the radios used by the race officials. They can also be reached by phone at 814-352-7814.
