WELCOME TO JACK FROST MOUNTAIN IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING TODAY'S RACE

ALL COMPETITORS IN USSA SANCTIONED RACES MUST HAVE A CURRENT USSA & PARA (OR OTHER STATE) MEMBERSHIP CARD TO PARTICIPATE.

INSPECTION:

All inspection must be done in a slide slipping fashion outside the course. No shadowing or warm-up free skiing will be allowed on the course. Any competitor not adhering to the INSPECTION rules will be disqualified.

RACE DETAILS:

Today's race will consist of two runs. The 2nd run will be reset and 2nd run inspection will begin approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour following the 1st run. The 2nd run start time will be posted on the Scoreboard, the Race Registration Room, and announced.

BIBS & LIFT TICKETS:

Bib Numbers must be carried at all times during course inspection. Lift Tickets MUST be worn and visible to ride the chairlift. Lift tickets can be worn on the goggles. There will be no line cutting privileges. Be sure to allow yourself enough time to be at the start in time for your run. Upon completion of the 2nd run, racers MUST return his/her bib to the Race Registration Room.

COURSE:

Once the race course is closed, no skier, except for the Race Jury and Course Maintenance Workers, will be allowed on the racing slope. Clothing can be carried down Thunderbolt, if it is open. No one is allowed in the Finish run out area. Upon a racer finishing the run, the racer should move immediately to the area outside of the finish.

REFEREE'S REPORT:

After the Referee posts the Referee's Report (Official DSQ List following each run) with the exact time of Posting, a racer may initiate a protest to the Race Jury. The protest MUST be initiated through his/her coach by completing the proper form accompanied with the appropriate protest fee. THIS MUST BE DONE WITHIN THE OFFICIAL FIFTEEN-MINUTE POSTING TIME. An unofficial Referee's Report will be posted on the Scoreboard. The official Referee's Report will be posted in the Race Registration Room.

SPORTSMANSHIP:

Any racer displaying poor sportsmanship, foul language, or not abiding by the Rules of the Race Committee or Jack Frost Ski Area can be disqualified by the jury, or upon request of the ski area without refund or race registration or lift ticket.

AWARDS:

Awards will take place approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour following completion of the 2nd run. Awards will be held in the Main Lodge or right outside the main lodge depending on weather.
