Lift tickets

\$41 Ages 6 and up (note: Lift tickets are discounted from \$45)
Children age 5 and under - free lift ticket with purchase of any full priced Adult Lift Ticket.

Lift tickets should be purchased on <u>alpinereg.com</u> at the time of racer registration. Tickets will be sold in the registration area each morning for payments of cash or check. If paying by credit card, lift tickets must be purchased at the ticket office **and no discount is offered**. **To facilitate registration**, **advanced purchase through <u>alpinereg.com</u> is recommended**.
