# TEAM SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA FOR SELECTION TO PARA STATE TEAM

Each race will be a Scored USSA race with the event result deciding the discipline champion. The overall champions and state team selection will be decided by the cumulative total of each run (5) using New World Cup points. Tie breaker methods apply as indicated in the PARA Championship guidelines.

## **SL & GS AWARDS**

Awards for individual Slalom and Giant Slalom will be determined by the combined run results for each discipline.

**REGULATION HELMETS** are mandatory for the Super G, Giant Slalom, and Slalom races

### **RACE BIBS**

Bibs for all three days for all events will be issued at registration. Bibs will be collected at the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> run on Sunday, March 1, 2015. A bib deposit of \$20 cash will be collected at registration and returned to the racer after Sunday's race.

#### **SPECTATORS**

Shuttle service is available between the Summit and the Valley for non-skiing spectators Walkers can hike up the side of the Homestretch trail to the finish area.

On Friday, Feb 27<sup>th</sup> for the Super G, **NO spectators will be allowed on Razor's Edge**, the race trail. Spectators may observe from the Challenge trail, the service trail from Dreamweaver, or the connector just above "The Falls." **For safety reasons all spectators MUST remain at least 7ft behind the b-netting.** We recommend that spectators observe from the finish area.
